1 Corinthians 2:1-5

The Message of the Gospel...

- ... Does not rely on "plausible" words.
 - 1 Corinthians 2:4 "and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power,"
- ... Does not rely on "eloquent" words.
 - 1 Corinthians 1:17 "or Christ did not send me to baptize but to <u>preach</u> the gospel, and not with words of eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power."
- ... Does not rely on man's wisdom or education.
 - 1 Corinthians 1:20 "Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made <u>foolish</u> the wisdom of the world?"
- ... Relies fully on Jesus Christ and the power of His death and resurrection to transform lives!

Paul was a living example of the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

- □ 1 Timothy 1:12-17
 - ❖ Paul was a blasphemer, a persecutor and an insolent opponent of Christianity!
- Philippians 3:1-16
 - ❖ Paul was very pious and <u>religious</u> yet not right with God!
- ☐ Acts 13:1-3
 - ❖ Paul was sent out to proclaim the gospel by the church at Antioch ... Miracles followed!
 f Paul & Barnabus at Cyprus & Antioch in Pisidia Acts 13:8-22
 f Paul and Barnabas at Lystra Acts 14:8-15
 f Paul and Silas at Philippi Acts 16:16-18, 25-34
 f Paul in Ephesus Acts 19:11-20
 f Paul at Troas Acts 20:7-12

The Gospel...

- ❖ The "Focus" of the Gospel is Jesus Christ.
- ❖ The "<u>Presentation</u>" of the Gospel is the Word of God.
- ❖ The "Result" of the true Gospel is that the faith of the followers will not rest on the wisdom of men but on the power of God!
