Daniel 1

In a hymn called "Dare to be a Daniel" written by Philip P. Bliss in the late 1800's, the chorus reads:

Dare to be a Daniel, Dare to stand alone!

Dare to have a purpose firm! Dare to make it known!

This hymn is based on the book of Daniel, the account of a young Hebrew who trusted in God and refused to compromise his faith!

The Book of Daniel – God's guide on how to thrive in a heathen culture!

Captivity Daniel 1:1-7

"... Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and besieged it. And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand ..."(verses 1-2)

2 Kings 24:1-4; 24:10-15; 25:7-12

- ❖ Daniel lost everything but his life! He lost his immediate family, his future in Jerusalem, his hope for a family of his own, his heritage, even his name!
- ❖ Daniel was forced to learn the ways of the Chaldeans and to honor the king.

Commitment Daniel 1:8-14

❖ Daniel was committed to God and His Word.

"Daniel resolved not to defile himself..." (verses 8)

Resolve: "To fix in opinion or purpose; to determine in mind. ..."

❖ Daniel would not compromise his Godly convictions in this heathen culture!

\$\times\$ Christians are called to keep our conduct honorable!

1 Peter 2:9-17

❖ God gave Daniel favor in the sight of his supervisor.

\$\ Joseph is another example of God giving favor.

Psalm 37:5-6 "Commit your way to the Lord; trust in Him, and He will act. He will bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday."

Confirmation Daniel 1:15-17

- ❖ Daniel put his faith in God, and God confirmed His Word and blessed Daniel's obedience!
 ❖ God blessed Daniel and his friends with exceptional health, wisdom and understanding!
- ❖ Daniel was not alone in his stand! Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego stood with him! "Test your servants…" (verse 12)

Hebrews 10:24 "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,"

❖ God responds to faith!

Matthew 9:29 "Then He touched their eyes, saying, 'According to your faith be it done to you.'"

Luke 7:9-10 "When Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him, and turning to the crowd that followed Him, said, 'I tell you, not even in Israel have I found such faith.' And when those who had been sent returned to the house, they found the servant well."
