Which one will you serve – God or Money? April 6th & 7th, 2013

Matthew 6:19-24

In this passage in Matthew, we read how Jesus gives insight into identifying our true allegiances. Jesus said, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." A quote from Martin Luther reiterates this point, "Whatever man loves, that is his God. For he carries it in his heart; he goes about with it night and day; he sleeps and wakes with it, …" Jesus warns His followers against regarding worldly possessions as treasures.

"On the contrary, He implies, they should make it their aim to use their material wealth wisely and generously, for by such wisdom and generosity they may well be adding to their true and abiding spiritual riches." ¹

□ 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Jesus clearly states the key point of His teaching: "No one can serve two masters"
